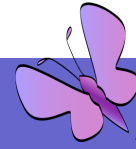


ROYAL CHARTER



S.T.O.P.S. (Small Towns Observe Pedestrian Safety)



It is the season for outdoor activities that includes walking, running and biking. There is also an increase in vehicle traffic. The Town asks everyone to be aware of each other.

Pedestrians and bicyclists are asked to cross roadways at the marked crosswalks if possible, use pedestrian signals if available and wear reflective clothing especially if out at night.

Motorists are asked to be aware of pedestrians and bicyclists at all times along the sidewalks especially waiting to cross the streets either in crosswalks or otherwise; and watch the speed limit, which is 25mph in Town limits unless otherwise posted. Vision greatly impaired at night. Please watch out for each other and work together to keep everyone safe.

FACT: The Town of Front Royal collects recyclable materials and transports them to Republic Services in Manassas, VA once a week.










FACT: The Town of Front Royal pays Republic Services to process materials based on material [per ton] delivered to the facility.

FACT: Items do not have to be separated. It's a Single Stream service.

FACT: Rules/Regulations listed below are established by Republic Services



FACT: The Town of Front Royal requires that the items be placed curbside before 7:00am or after 7:00pm the night before your Recycling Day.
